10-12; 13-15 and 16-18

By Technique: Color Film; Black and White Film; Color Digital; Black and White Digital (no manipulation); Alternative, like Polaroid or pinhole and a special combining your favorite photo and an essay about how photography contributes to community. Two photographs per person in any category.

Anyone 18 or under is eligible to enter their work...and it must be your work!
